## **Parent and Carer Consultation Evening Information**

As we approach our first round of parent consultation meetings for this new school year, I would like to inform you of some significant changes.

As you are aware, every school in the Country is strictly following the Government's COVID-19 control measures in order to keep our pupils and staff safe. Therefore, we cannot have any 'face to face' meetings, as we have to limit the amount of visitors entering our school site.

This means that our parent consultation meetings will be held remotely via telephone. You will still be able to book a 10 meeting slot using our online system (instructions on the reverse of this letter).

Prior to parents' evening, your child will take home, three photocopied pieces of work (English, Maths plus another example from a further curriculum area) for you to look at and keep. You are welcome to use this evidence of your child's learning as a talking point during your telephone conversation with your child's class teacher. Parents' evening conversations for our Nursery children will be based around Tapestry and how the children are settling into Nursery.

As this is a new way of us communicating with parents, during parent consultation evenings, please be aware that some teachers may be slightly late in contacting you if any conversations run over the allotted time; so please make sure that your phone is turned on and that it's not in silent mode. The words 'Blocked', 'No Caller ID' or 'Private' will appear on your phone instead of the school's number when your child's teacher calls you. Please be aware that they will try twice to contact you during your 10-minute slot before moving on to their next meeting. If you are a two-parent family, living together, then you are welcome to put the call on speaker to both share in the conversation.

## Parents Evening

Good news! Parents Evening just got a whole lot easier because you can now book your appointments online.

We will send a link to your mobile phone or email address which will take you to our online booking system to select a time convenient for you. Please follow these simple steps to book your slot:

1. Click the link that you receive through text and/or email to take you to the confirmation page. You will need internet access to do this.
2. Enter your child's first name to continue. If you have more than one child, any of their first names will work.
3. Next you will be taken to the booking page. This will show your children alongside all of the teachers that you can book in with.
4. Click 'Please Choose' to be shown a list of available times that you can click to book. This will even give you the option to add any notes that you might want the teacher to see before the meeting.
5. **In the notes section please add the number you would like your child's class teacher to call you on.**
6. After you have entered your preferred phone number in the notes section, please click 'Book this Slot' to complete your booking. When the button has turned green you know your booking has been made.
7. At any time before the Parents Evening, you can click the link on your phone or email again to check your booking time or even un-book by clicking the green booked button.

Make sure you book your parents evening ASAP to ensure you get the best time for you.
