For our Harvest Festival, we are asking you to kindly donate dried foods, tins, breakfast cereals or any other non-perishable food items. After the assembly, all donations will be collected by the South Leeds Network Foodbank, who support disadvantaged and vulnerable families in our local community. Please bring into school your Harvest donations from tomorrow, Wednesday 16th October 2019.

Also, to celebrate Bonfire Night we are holding a disco after school on **Wednesday 6th November 2019.**

Entrance is £3.00 which will include pizza, a drink and an ice-cream. To enable your child to attend, please add their name on the guest list. From Wednesday 16th October, a member of school staff will be at the Key stage 1 playground window before and after school to take names. Alternatively, please send the exact money in a sealed envelope clearly stating your child's name, class and 'School Disco'. Due to health and safety, the last day to buy tickets will be Friday 25th November 2019. Please ensure staff are made aware of any special dietary requirements and that a responsible adult is available to collect your child promptly.

KS1- Children attending the first disco can bring a change of clothing in a clearly named plastic bag. Please ensure staff are made aware of any special dietary requirements. After the disco has finished KS1 children will be brought to their classrooms to collect their coats. They will then leave by their usual exits to be safely collected in the KS1 playground.

KS2- On entering the disco, children need to line up at the office entrance at 4.40pm at the earliest. The doors will be open at 4.50pm promptly and the children will be registered. Parents of KS2 children need to collect your child/children from the school hall at 6.15pm. The external door will be open from 6.10pm.

At the end of each disco all children must be collected promptly by a responsible adult.
