## Guidance for Parents Re: Covid-19 Coronavirus

### Update 4

Dear Parents/ Carers,

**As you will know, schools in England will be closed from Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March until further notice.**

**Please follow these key principles:**

- 1. If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be.**
- 2. Do not rely on grandparents, friends or family members with underlying health conditions for childcare**
- 3. Do everything you can to ensure that children are not mixing in a way which can continue to spread the virus. They should observe the same social distancing as adults.**

If your work is critical to the COVID-19 response, or you work in one of the critical sectors outlined by the Government (key workers) then you may have been allocated a place at our school setting as we move forward with offering child care provision and support the fight against this pandemic. If you are eligible for this support then you will receive further additional guidance about logistics.

We will be following Government guidelines as to when schools will open and shall very much look forward to welcoming everyone back in (hopefully) the not too distant future.

In the mean time, remember to **check the school website for updates**. From Monday the home learning section will be ‘live’ and teachers will share with you and pupils a range of tasks to help keep them busy and focussed during this difficult time.
