### What to expect from Beeston Primary School.

#### Dear Parent/Carer

If your child's bubble closes your child's class teacher will upload a series of lessons/tasks, on a daily basis, to support your child's learning at home. It is now statutory that your child engages with these home learning tasks, unless they are ill themselves.

It is important that you supervise your child when they are accessing Teams. The chat function will be made available during the hours of the school day, so children can ask questions relating to their learning only. Any inappropriate comments or messages unrelated will be deleted and contact will be made with parents/carers.

What type of learning will be set for your child and how often?

#### Nursery:

Subject Area	Frequency
Maths	Twice a week with extension activities when appropriate
Literacy	Twice a week with extension activities when appropriate
Phonics	As appropriate, depending on the time of the year
Wider Curriculum	Three times a week
Moving and Handling	Once a week
Sharing a Story	Three times a week

#### Reception:

Subject Area	Frequency
Maths	Three times a week (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday)
Literacy	Three times a week (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday)
Phonics	Daily
Wider Curriculum	Daily
Sharing a Story	Four times a week
Restorative Circle	Wednesday only

Nursery and Reception will use Tapestry to share these learning tasks with you. This is how you will share what your child has learnt at home too.

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#### Year 1:

Subject Area	Frequency
Maths	Daily
Literacy	Daily
Phonics/Reading	Daily
Science	Twice weekly
Wider Curriculum	Twice weekly, this will include Physical Education and PSHE
Other	Your child's class teacher will set occasional tasks such as spellings or timetables practise in addition to their main learning task. This could differ depending on your child's year group or the time of the year the bubble closes.
Sharing a Story	Three times a week

#### Years 2-6:

Subject Area	Frequency
Maths	Daily
Literacy	Daily
Reading	This will be a shorter task and will be set daily
Science	Twice weekly
Wider Curriculum	Twice weekly, this will include Physical Education and PSHE
Other	Your child's class teacher will set occasional tasks such as spellings or timetables practise in addition to their main learning task. This could differ depending on your child's year group.
Sharing a Story	Three times a week

If your child is in Years 1-6 then these tasks will be set using Microsoft Teams. This is how your child will share what they have learnt in school too.

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
