Dear Parents and Carers,

## Arrangements for the re-opening of Beeston Primary School.

The Prime Minister announced yesterday that the Government has set out its plan for the return of all pupils to schools. This means that Beeston Primary School will return to face-to-face education on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. This is compulsory for all pupils as the usual rules and duties around school attendance will be in place from this date.

We will continue with our staggered starts and ends to the school day as these limit the amount of families on the school playground at one time. Please can I remind you that to avoid further congestion, one family member is allowed on the playground with their child and that face coverings are compulsory when entering the school grounds to drop off or collect your children.

The following school times have been slightly amended and will be used from the 8<sup>th</sup> March for all children.

**Please ensure you are prompt. Being early or late will cause a problem for others as we need to keep large gatherings to a minimum, so please play your part and follow the rules in order to keep everyone safe.**

Please remember that if you have children who are in both Key stage 1 and Key Stage 2, that you can drop them off at the same time at 8.30am.

The Prime Minister stated that schools are a safe place for all. If you would like to view our COVID-19 safety measures, then please download our Leeds City Council’s risk assessment from our school website.

Once school re-opens to all pupils we will be focusing on pupils’ mental health and wellbeing, and prioritising a catch up curriculum for missed learning. Next week, Mrs Tidey will be providing further details regarding this, once the Government has released their COVID-catch up plans. She will also explain our updated procedures for further bubble closures.

Next week is our parent and carer consultation week. I do hope you find it informative. Together we can support our children in returning to full-time education.
