KS1 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs)

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may be aware, statutory assessments in both KS1 and KS2 (taken in Year 6) will be going ahead this year, following cancellations in 2020 and 2021. In KS1, the results of this testing will not be submitted to the government but will be an important part of informing our teacher assessments and will give teachers a better understanding of where the gaps in knowledge are, so they can plan their teaching around those gaps.

We will be carrying out these assessments on the week beginning May 16th. The week will consist of two reading tests and two maths tests which will be spread out throughout the week. Children will come to school as normal and will carry out the test in a non-pressurised environment, where they will be encouraged to try their best and will be rewarded at the end of the week in order to celebrate their efforts. Pupils' next steps and targets will be shared with parents as part of the end of year reports.
