Dear Parents and Carers,

Outlined below are lessons and activities your child should access if they are unable to attend school for a period during this half term, due to various reasons, which does not include your child being unwell. We recommend your child completes Literacy, Phonics and Maths lessons daily, along with an activity from a different area of learning. Other activities such as baking, dancing, singing, being creative and using technology are also important. Remember play is essential at this age and should be encouraged at home too.
