

Dear Parent/Carers,

For many of you this will be your final Nursery term with us. Here is a brief outline of the work your child will be covering this half term.

Physical Development-

This half term the children will be focusing on:-
Gross Motor -experimenting with different ways of moving.
Fine Motor handling tools, objects and construction safely and with increasing control.

Listening, Attention and Understanding-

This half term we will be listening to stories with increasing attention and recall. We will be encouraging the children to listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion. The children will be encouraged to use more complex sentences to link thoughts (e.g. using and, because).

Personal Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be encouraging the children talk about who their friends are to tell you what they like to do with them. We will be talking to the children about Reception and introducing the children to their new teachers and classes ready for transition.

Understanding the World

People, Culture and Communities The children can talk about going to big school in September
The World—The children can talk about some of the things I have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects. I can talk about growth and decay.



Exploring and using media and materials-

We will be encouraging the children to build in 3D
 We will be encouraging the children to dance to the music.

Being Imaginative

We will be acting out stories with our friends

Maths

Number- The children will be looking at more and less and splitting numbers up into groups.
Numerical Pattern- The children will be looking at naming shapes and making shape pictures

Literacy

This half term we will be encouraging the children to recognise their name and the letters in their name. For writing we will be retracing lines and follow writing patterns. We will be encouraging children to copy some letters in my name and labels.

We will be developing our knowledge of the wider world by looking at plants and the environment around us

Aspiring Entrepreneurs

As Aspiring Entrepreneurs, we will begin to challenge ourselves to have a go with the help and support of our friends.

Healthy and Happy Living

We will continue to use our outdoor area to learn and grow.
 We will look at developing friendships through our play and games.

Inquisitive Investigators

We will develop our questioning minds by look at how things change.
