Dear Parent /Carer,

This year, we are holding our Harvest Festival Celebration in the school hall on Friday 21st October.

Unfortunately, as the Harvest Festival is a whole school celebration and due to health and safety regulations and space in the hall, we are unable to invite parents to this event. However, we will arrange other family events throughout the year, which you will be invited to.

For our Harvest Festival, we are asking you to kindly donate dried foods, tins, breakfast cereals or any other non-perishable food items. After the assembly, the South Leeds Network Foodbank, who supports disadvantaged and vulnerable families in our local community, will collect all donations. All items should be unopened, in date and in good condition, as the foodbank are forbidden by law to give away food that has passed its “use by” date.

Last year Leeds South and East Foodbank provided food to 6,495 adults and 4,509 children in our local community. This required over 87860 tonnes to provide 209,190 meals to families and individuals in need. In the current economic climate your help, and assistance will be invaluable in providing support to people that need it.
