Dear Parents/Carers,

Children in Year 5 have the opportunity each year to participate in a residential visit. This year our residential will be a two night, three-day stay at Lineham Farm Children’s Centre, Eccup, Leeds 16. The date of the visit is **Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2025 – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025**. The total cost of the visit is **£180** which includes: coach travel, accommodation including all meals and qualified instructors to lead the activities, and equipment hire.

The trip provides the children with opportunities to learn about the environment, demonstrates the importance of teamwork and allows the children to put their problem solving and communication skills to the test.

All of the outdoor activities are led by experienced members of staff from Lineham Farm and the children are split into four groups. The children take part in a whole range of activities including: cycling, climbing, country walking, animal care and ‘Lineham explorers’. They will experience the great outdoors and have the opportunity to build their own dens and roast marshmallows on a fire.

The children take on responsibilities such as making their own beds on arrival, washing the pots after dinner and keeping their rooms tidy. They enjoy tasty meals each day and during the evenings, play in the games room and explore the grounds on a night walk.

In order to secure a place, please make a £20 non-refundable deposit no later than **Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2025** via your child’s SchoolMoney account. When making payment, please also tick the parental consent box on the payment screen in order to proceed. Please note, the number of pupils who can join the trip is capped at 32 and so places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

**If you would like to withdraw your child from the trip, please email the school office no later than Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2025. It is important to note that for any withdrawals from the trip after 5<sup>th</sup> January 2025, parents/carers will be liable to pay the full balance of £180.**

The remaining balance can be paid in instalments with the deadline for final payment being **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025**.

I would like to invite you to a meeting on **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2024 at 3.30pm** in the school hall where I will provide further information about the visit and answer any questions that you may have. At the end of school on that day, please collect your child from the playground as normal and then make your way to the fire door at the back of the school hall to sign in.

I hope to see as many of you as possible at the meeting but if you are unable to attend and would like more information about the visit, please do not hesitate to contact me.
