Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the Upper Key Stage 2 PHSE curriculum, we will be delivering a series of lessons under the heading of Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) to Year 5 pupils the week beginning **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2025.** 

Our aims are to encourage children to reflect and understand both the physical and emotional changes that affect them at this time. The lessons will focus on:

- \* The way we grow and change throughout the human lifecycle
- \* The physical changes associated with puberty
- \* Menstruation
- \* The impact of puberty on physical hygiene and strategies for managing this
- \* How puberty affects emotions
- \* How to deal with feelings in the context of relationships
- \* Where to seek support and advice when they need it

Lessons will be delivered by class teachers in classes offering optimum ease for discussion in a safe environment. Through circle time, quizzes, videos and discussions, children will engage with the different areas within the topic.

We will be holding a PSHE meeting so that there is an opportunity for parents and carers to view the materials in full. The meeting will take place on **Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> April at 9:00am**.

We hope you will agree with us that this work is vitally important for children, that it needs to be done age-appropriately and that our agreed syllabus (which can all be found on the school website) gives us a secure way to do this.

We hope you, like us, will see the materials as educationally sound and beneficial to our children, helping to safeguard them.
