## **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2025 will be Transition Mornings at Beeston Primary School.**

This is always an exciting time in school as children and staff begin preparations for the next academic year.

The main aims of transition sessions are to give children and staff an opportunity to get to know each other and to enable children, staff and parents to gain an understanding of new routines and expectations for the upcoming year.

This year, we have decided to run two morning transition sessions in school (rather than the full days held previous years). This is in response to feedback from staff and pupils in school and will help us to avoid challenges over lunch time logistics in school. The children will also start both days in their existing classrooms and teachers will explain to pupils drop off and collection arrangements so they are clear where they need to go in September.

As the end of this academic year approaches, we will be wishing a fond farewell to several staff members. Mr Brannan and Miss Dews will be leaving Beeston Primary School to take up a teaching post elsewhere in the city; Miss Dalrymple has decided to take some time away from teaching and will be travelling to Australia and Mrs Callaghan will be starting her own tutoring business. Several Teaching Assistants are also leaving to take up positions elsewhere and we say good bye to Mrs Quinn, Mrs Khan, Miss Schofield and Mrs Poules. We would like to thank them for all they have done for the pupils at our school and wish them every success in the future. Mrs O'Dea, Mrs Swain and Mr Bramhall will also be taking some time away from school next academic year as they continue their maternity and paternity leaves. I am sure you will join me in wishing them all the very best of luck in their new chapters.

We will be welcoming four new teachers to school from September. Mr Redmile, Miss Cassidy, Miss McConn and Mr Walton. Mrs Khan is also joining us as a Higher-Level Teaching Assistant (HLTA) – all five will be in school for our transition sessions to meet staff, parents and pupils.
