- Working closely with Leeds Young Carers Support Service to provide ongoing guidance and resources.

A young carer is a child or young person who helps care for a family member with a physical or mental health condition, a disability, or challenges related to substance misuse. Often, families may not realise their child is taking on a caring role, but recognising this can help us provide the right support at the right time.
