Next half term, we are enhancing the curriculum and we are delighted to share some exciting news with you about an upcoming event. On Monday 2nd and Tuesday 3rd February 2026, our school will be hosting a special visitor Sam from the Boffin Project! Each year this has been an amazing opportunity for children to see how sounds are made and learn how to make musical instruments. Children always say it is a highlight of the year.

To make these amazing experiences happen, we really need your support. We're asking for a £5.47 voluntary contribution from each child to help us fund the visit.
