Year 6 will be visiting Flamingo Land on:

Tuesday 30th June 2026

As well as a wide variety of theme park rides, there is also a zoo and large playground for the children to enjoy there which will give them an opportunity to spend some quality time with their classmates before leaving for high school.

The cost of this trip is £42.44 - payment for the trip can be made online via your Arbor Parent Portal or Parent App. **As this trip is an optional extra in addition to your child's usual national curriculum visits, without payment your child will not be able to attend.**

On the day of the trip, we will be leaving school by coach promptly at 8:30am; all children who are going to Flamingo Land must be in school earlier than usual, arriving no later than 8:15am. Pupils can arrive from 8:00am onwards, entering school via the main office; if your child usually attends breakfast club, they are still able to attend breakfast club and have breakfast before going to the Year 6 area. We will arrive back at approximately 5:50pm. The arrival time back in school is dependent on traffic, but school will send an update via email/In-App message if there are any delays.

In order to secure a place, please make a **£20 non-refundable deposit** no later than **Friday May 8th 2026** via the 'school shop' section on Arbor. By making the deposit payment, you are giving consent for your child to attend the trip. After the deposit amount has been paid, the remaining balance amount of £22.44 will be added to 'school shop' as a separate payment. The deadline for full payment will be **Monday 1st June 2026. If you need to discuss payment or would like to pay in instalments, please contact the school office on 0113 2716978.**

Please note: Unfortunately, we are unable to consider refunds for non-attendance as the school is committed to non-refundable deposits and payments at the time of booking trips and educational visits.

Important Information:

- **Your child's current medical conditions and dietary/medical information will be taken from school records. If there are any changes to your child's details; as a matter of urgency, you must update via your Arbor account or call/email the school office to update.**
- **If there are any changes to your child's emergency contact details from the information that you have provided school with previously, you must update via your Arbor account or call/email the school office to advise accordingly.**

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the office will send out further communication via email nearer to the trip date to confirm if a meal is required.
